



Marlborough Youth FC – Membership Terms and Conditions

Please note: the following membership terms and conditions are in addition to the Club Rules of Marlborough Youth FC by which all members of the Club agree to be bound.

Parental responsibility

Team Managers and coaches cannot accept parental responsibility while leading Club activities. Players should not be left unaccompanied by a parent or other known responsible adult without the agreement of the Team Manager or a coach. If a player is to be collected by someone other than his/her parent or guardian, the Team Manager or a coach must be informed beforehand.

Medication

Team Managers and coaches are not permitted to administer medication to players. The player's parent or guardian MUST organise any administration of medication/s or treatment/s required for any known condition.

Discipline

The issuing of cautions to a player and the sending off of a player incur a fine levied by the FA or the relevant league. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the player concerned to refund the Club for payment of these fines.

No pay no play policy

Under the Club's insurance arrangements, players are only covered if their membership fees are paid up. As a result, the Club reserves the right to not allow a player to train with or play for the Club where their membership fees are overdue.

MYFC team playing kit

The Club's team playing kit (shirts, shorts, socks) are all procured from the Club's kit supplier using sponsorship funds or, where necessary, contributions from parents and remain the property of the Club at all times. This kit must be returned to the Team Manager when a player leaves the Club or grows out of it. The kit can only be used for Club purposes and needs to be kept in good condition, subject to reasonable wear and tear. And whilst the Club aims to issue a set of playing kit to each player for the whole season wherever we can, if a team is short we may need to take kits back and/or rotate after matches or from time to time. If lost or damaged, replacement items will need to be paid for by parents.
